Assignment

Research at least two options for air transportation to your destination. A chart is provided on page 2 that might help with comparing options, but you are welcome to use any format. Explain the following:

- How do the itineraries themselves compare? Are there differences in the total travel time, time spent on layovers, or other conveniences/inconveniences to the itineraries?
- How do the terms and conditions compare for changing the airline ticket?
- Are there any other factors that you would consider in picking one of these options?

Additionally, plan a side trip that you could do before, during, or after your program. Part of the response may be in an outline form, but do include a descriptive writing to answer the questions as well.

- What do you hope to do or see and why? Does this side trip contribute to the goals you outlined in your first essay, and if so, how?
- What is your itinerary for this travel? Specifically outline the means of transportation and the dates and times of a possible trip. Example: "On Friday, June 12, I plan to take the Eurostar train that departs London St. Pancras International at 10:24am for Paris."
- Are there any holidays or other events that impact when you would travel or what you would see? Are there any other factors that impact your planning?

Due to the personal nature of travel planning, this essay likely will not require references but you are welcome to use them if they are helpful. If you do use references, you must cite them but you may use whichever method of citation is most common in your field.
