

Scholarships for Study Abroad

Students considering studying abroad are highly encouraged to apply for study abroad scholarships. Apply early--most scholarship deadlines fall from November-April for study abroad conducted any time during the next academic year. The listing here is a short sampling of the many scholarships available. NDSU Scholarships

NDSU Student Miles Scholarship: The Office of International Student & Study Abroad Services is excited to award free airline tickets for study around the world. Preference is given to students who receive the Pell Grant and to students with financial need.

John and Susan Wold Scholarship: \$1,000 scholarships awarded to students with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Preference given to Minnesota/North Dakota residents studying abroad for a full year.

Sudhir Mehta Memorial Study Abroad Scholarship: A \$1,000 scholarship given to a student with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Preference given to students studying in India or Southeast Asia.

James A. Meier Study Abroad Scholarship: \$1500 scholarships awarded for students who study abroad on a semester or summer program. Preference is given to students with financial need. Applicants must have a 2.75 GPA or higher.

James A. Meier Camino de Santiago Scholarship: \$1000 scholarships to support students taking part in the NDSU faculty-led Camino de Santiago program with Dr. Carlos Hawley. Preference is given to students with financial need. Applicants must have a 2.75 GPA or higher.

Kevin and Jean Melicher Family Scholarship: \$1500 scholarship for a student who has declared a major or minor in an academic field directly related to healthcare, and is available to students participating in a study abroad program during spring 2015 on any type of program.

Laurel Sparks Study Abroad Scholarship: \$1000 scholarship awarded to a student majoring in a modern language.

Scholarships specific to exchange and direct programs are also available to students for a variety of different universities.

Diversity Scholarships

DiversityAbroad.com Scholarships: \$1,000 scholarships awarded; economically disadvantaged students, African-American, Asian-American, Hispanic/Latino and Native-American students are strongly encouraged to apply.

Gilman Scholarship: Scholarships of up to \$8,000 are awarded, with the goal to diversify students who study abroad and the countries and regions where they go.

Fund for Education Abroad Rainbow Scholarship: A scholarship will be awarded to a deserving LGBT student who aims to participate in an education abroad program.

Major and National Scholarships

ISEP Scholarships: \$500-\$2,000 scholarships awarded to students studying abroad in Austria, France, Germany, or Switzerland.

Gilman Scholarship: Funded by Congress and the US Department of State, scholarships of up to \$8,000 are awarded to students studying in non-traditional study abroad destinations.

Boren Scholarship: Scholarships of up to \$20,000 awarded for studying abroad in an areas of US interest (Africa, Asia, Middle East, Latin America, Eastern Europe).

Critical Language Scholarship: This is a fully funded 7- to 10-week program aimed at studying a critical language in the corresponding country. Countries include China, India, Japan, Russia, Turkey, Egypt, and others.

Foundation for Global Scholars: A variety of scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$2,500 are available for students studying anywhere abroad for any amount of time.

Fund for Education Abroad: Grants and scholarships up to \$10,000 are available for American students to participate in high-quality, rigorous education abroad programs.
